



## **NATIONAL HIGH PERFORMANCE PROGRAMME DIRECTOR**

IHA requires a highly skilled and organised individual to fill the position of National High Performance Programme Director (HPPD).

The National High Performance Programme Director (HPPD) is responsible for leading and implementing Ice Hockey Australia's contribution to high performance targets, developing strategies to ensure the sustained success of our sport and teams at the elite level. In addition to leading coaches and staff within the national programs in Australia, you will lead and drive our state network, ensuring that the input of all stakeholders is maximized and aligned to the IHA high performance strategy and agreed national direction.

The National High Performance Programme Director is responsible for the coordination, administration, implementation and general supervision of IHA's National High Performance Program in conjunction with the National Coaching Program Director and the National Player Development Program Director.

This position requires good organisational and management skills as well as the very critical skill of communication. This is a voluntary role.

### **Specific Responsibilities/Duties:**

- advise the Board on all matters relating to IHA's National High Performance Program;
- establish, manage and chair the operation of the IHA High Performance Programme Council;
- through the IHA's National High Performance Programme Council propose, recommend, plan, create, develop, administer and supervise all high performance programs under the jurisdiction of IHA, in particular the promotion and implementation of the IHA national teams alignment process.
- assist in the promotion of high performance programs within the states.
- conduct High Performance seminars / workshops in states as required and approved by IHA.
- prepare and/or update player/ staff performance guidelines to maintain a uniform standard of expectations in the high performance program.
- make recommendations to the continual improvement of the High Performance Program.
- attend High Performance camps and competitions, as approved by IHA.
